SO HOW DO I REGISTER FOR MUSIC LESSONS HERE?

CAN I LEARN ANYTHING AT ALL?

I LEARNT LAST YEAR, DO I CARRY OVER TO NEXT YEAR?

No, you must apply each new calendar year for lessons using a new form.

Possibly it does, but you should write this on the form to double check.
